News

Year 11 Exams

Year 11 exams start on Monday for the next two weeks. The regular school timetable for Year 11 is suspended to enable these examinations to take place. This is a crucial set of examinations for the Year 11 students allowing them to demonstrate their progress to date and to help inform their choices post-16. Feedback from these examinations will be used to determine the tier of entry in those subjects where it applies. In the current situation with regard to disruption caused by the pandemic, it is entirely possible that these assessments will also be used as evidence towards final performance by the examining bodies next summer. When not in an exam, students should be at home revising. All students will have received their individual exam timetables; a copy of

the overall timetable is attached to the newsletter. Normal timetable for Year 11 resumes on Monday 6th December.
