Year 9 Option Choices for Key Stage 4

Next week, Year 9 pupils will receive detailed information to bring home regarding the options process. This information will help them choose four subjects that they wish to study, in addition to the core curriculum, during years 10 and Y11. This information will also be emailed out to parents, together with an options form to record their choice of subjects.

As part of the process to assist with these choices, a virtual parents' evening for Year 9 will take place with subject teachers on Tuesday 15th February. After this, your son will have until Friday 4th March to complete his choices and return the options form.

School Meals

As you may be aware, the local authority have provided funds to deal with any existing debt for school meals. From Monday, there will be a spending cap of £5 deficit imposed on all accounts. Once this limit is reached, students will no longer be able to use their account. However, in cases of financial hardship we may be able to help, so please contact your son's house office. You can keep track of your son's spending using ParentPay and you can also set up an

auto top up (which is suspended during school holidays) so that the account does not go overdrawn. If you haven't yet activated your account, please contact us and we can send you an activation code. You can also use ParentPay to pay for school trips, revision guides, ties and badges etc.

Clothing Support Grant

If any parents are struggling to pay for items of school uniform, coat, shoes or PE kit, the local authority can help. You can contact us in complete confidence regarding the items you need help with and school can purchase them on your behalf.
