On Monday, a group of Year 9 will take part in an event in school looking at artificial intelligence.

On Wednesday, 50 Year 9/10 students are attending the UK Imaging and Oncology Congress at Liverpool's Echo Arena, which comprises a key speaker presentation, careers guidance and a taster interactive session and hands on exhibition where they will have the opportunity to learn about the basics of radiological and imaging science and medicine.

Birkenhead Priory


This week has seen another three groups of Year 7 forms visit Birkenhead Priory. Next week it is the turn of 7G1, who go on Friday.
