Year 11 Mock Examinations

Class Charts

We are using a new behaviour management software called Class Charts. This allows us to quickly record and monitor both sanctions for poor behaviour, and rewards for good behaviour. It also has apps for both parents and students. The Class Charts app also allows teachers to communicate with parents.

Punctuality

Good punctuality at school is essential for students to achieve their full educational potential. It is also vital for students to form good habits for later life. All students are expected to arrive punctually for school in the morning. The expectation is that all students should be on site by 8.40am and in their form room ready to start the day at 8.45am.

We would ask parents to support us in maintaining good punctuality by:-

- Ensuring their child wakes up in plenty of time to be ready and prepared for school.
- Ensuring their child has organised their bag and equipment the night before so that this does not delay departure in the morning.
- Discussing any issues of lateness to ensure this does not become a habit.
- Monitoring their child's attendance record when it is sent home and looking for patterns of lateness.

Sanctions will be put in place for students who are late to school without a valid reason and persistent issues with punctuality will be addressed with parents. If you are aware that your child is likely to be late to school, please inform the school office, the relevant house office or our attendance officer, Mrs Kennedy.

National Tutoring Programme

As part of the National Tutoring Programme, we are looking for people in the community who are proficient in tutoring either maths, English, science, geography, history, modern foreign languages or computer science. Tutors need not have a teaching qualification, but must have enough knowledge in their chosen subject to support the students in their group(s). Successful candidates will be tutoring small
