# **Theatre Performance**

Tomorrow, Year 10 will be watching a theatre production called Grass. The production addresses the importance of a moral compass when it comes to reporting serious violent crime and how someone's involvement in violent crime can impact their mental health. Grass was written by Perception Theatre. The production has been produced in partnership with Evolving Mindset CIC and funded by Merseyside VRP. The story was co-developed with young people across Merseyside and their input has heavily influenced the narrative, themes and issues covered within the production. The production will challenge the culture around being labelled a 'grass' and the connotations and perceptions that accompany the label, to empower young people to report serious violent crime.
