Key Stage 4 Independent Study on Google Classroom

This year we will be setting all independent study tasks via Google Classroom. **Homework will no longer appear on the SIMS Parent app**, instead you can monitor your son's work via Google Guardianship (see below).

Google Classroom Codes

All Google Classroom codes can be found on the school website under the menu option **Students** and in the menu option **Remote Learning**. Codes are case sensitive so we recommend students copy and paste them.

Independent Study Timetable

You will find an independent study timetable for this academic year at the end of this letter.

Google Guardianship

As a guardian, you can get email summaries about your son's activity in Google Classroom. In the email summaries, you can review:

- Missing work work not turned in when the summary was sent.
- Upcoming work work that is due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or that is due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails).
- Class activities announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers.
- Email summaries do not include grades.

Registering for Email Summaries

To get email summaries of your son's work, you must accept the email invitation from our Google administrator. You will have 120 days to accept any invitation before it expires. You are able to unsubscribe from summaries or remove yourself as a guardian at any time.

- 1. The teacher or administrator emails you an invitation to join your son's class.
- 2. In your email program, open your email invitation.
- 3. Click Accept to confirm.
- 4. You will be offered the chance to receive daily or weekly email summaries (we recommend that you set up **weekly summaries**).
- 5. When you accept an invitation, you and your son get an email confirmation.

Training Students

To ensure students are well prepared to engage with learning outside of school we have spent time in their ICT lessons upskilling boys in the use of Google Classroom and introducing them to new software we have purchased this year.

Rewarding and Monitoring

Students can expect regular feedback and rewards for their efforts. They will receive up to 30 achievement points for every piece of work submitted. You will be able to monitor achievements in the SIMS Parent app. You may receive texts, a phone call, email or letters home if a student persistently fails to engage in independent study.

What's new?

We have created a new area on our school website called **Remote Learning.** In this area you will find key information about all aspects of home learning including how to find daily classwork if your son is self-isolating or has been absent from school.

You will find class codes for all Google Classrooms for all subjects in this area of the website. There are help guides to support students and parents too.

We are also excited to report that we have recently invested in two new online learning platforms – GCSEPod and Hegarty Maths. You will have received some recent communication from us regarding these purchases but to find out more about how these packages can support your son's learning visit the Remote Learning area on our website.
