

## Reporting a Covid -19 Test Result

<p>Click <b>Start Now</b></p>	<h3>Report a COVID-19 test result</h3> <p>Use this service to report your result to the NHS after using a coronavirus (COVID-19) lateral flow test kit.</p> <p>A lateral flow test is a coronavirus test you do yourself. It shows you the result on a handheld device that comes with the test.</p> <p>Report the result:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• every time you use a lateral flow test kit</li><li>• as soon as possible after you get the result</li></ul> <p>You cannot report a result after more than 24 hours.</p> <p><a href="#">Start now &gt;</a></p>
<p>Who are you reporting for – choose <b>Myself</b> if you are over 16 years old</p> <p>Or <b>Someone else</b> if your child is under 16</p>	<h3>Who are you reporting a result for?</h3> <p><input type="radio"/> Myself</p> <p><input type="radio"/> Someone else</p>
<p>At this point you are asked to create an account or continue without.</p> <p>This is up to you.</p> <p><b>If you do set up an account it is a lot quicker in the future!</b></p>	<h3>Would you like to sign in or create an account to save your details?</h3> <p><input type="radio"/> <b>Sign in or create an account</b> We'll save your details each time you report a test result. Creating an account only takes 2 minutes and you'll save 5 minutes when reporting each test result.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> <b>Continue without an account</b> Your details won't be saved for future tests and all information will have to be re-entered.</p>
<p>Once registered, you have this screen.</p> <p>Choose <b>“A school, college or other education provider”</b>.</p>	<h3>Who was the test for?</h3> <p>If you're reporting a result for someone else, answer for them.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> An adult social care setting - like a care home</p> <p><input checked="" type="radio"/> A school, college or other education provider</p> <p><input type="radio"/> The NHS as part of staff testing (NHS England, Wales and Northern Ireland only)</p> <p><input type="radio"/> An employer (not listed above) as part of their workplace testing programme</p> <p><input type="radio"/> None of the above</p>

## What's the name or postcode of the school or college?

Enter the name of the school or college or its postcode and select from the options provided. This is case sensitive.

If you cannot find it, enter the full postcode on its own.
