We kick off this term by introducing a new author - Onjali Q. Raúf. Her work draws heavily on her experiences and work for organisations including Women for Women International and as founder and CEO of the NGO's Making Herstory - an organisation that helps women and children who are victims of domestic violence, abuse and trafficking. Her first novel, *The Boy at the Back of the Class* - a moving and very funny story of children befriending a refugee at school, was influenced by her personal experience working at the border camps in Calais. This novel was a huge hit and won the Waterstones Children's Book

Prize in 2019. Since then she has written a number of fantastic and heart warming children's books including: *The Star Outside My Window, The Night Bus Hero* and *The Lion Above the Door.*
