#### **Sixth Form Financial Literacy Workshops**

Our first round of financial literacy workshops run by Stephen Reid from Community Capacity Builders CIC began this week. The Year 12 students engaged well and some positive feedback was received. We are looking forward to continuing to work with Stephen for the rest of this term. Thank you to the parents of Year 12 who have supported Mrs Danher in encouraging their son/daughter to participate in the sessions.

#### **New Futures Employability Programme**

In the next few weeks, students in years 12, 13 & 14 will be offered an opportunity to work with an employability mentor from New Futures. This is an initiative for young people aged 15 - 29 living in Wirral who are at risk of not finding employment or training, or who will not be continuing with further or higher education upon completion of their A levels. New Futures is a 1-2-1 mentoring service, which works with young people individually and during group sessions to break down their needs and goals, to then support them to plan the steps to get there. Mrs Danher and her team are currently identifying students who they feel will benefit from

this service and parents will be informed of dates and times of the sessions.

#### **Maths Support Sessions**

After the success of the first two support sessions, we are now offering another session to any parent who would like to attend. It will be an after school session on 8<sup>th</sup> March 2022 from 4pm – 5.15pm, which will demonstrate the ways in which we teach maths and how your son learns in our lessons.

This session will develop your own understanding of maths, in order to support your son with his maths work. By showing you different strategies of learning and teaching maths, as well as using the concrete manipulatives that we use in most of our maths lessons, we hope that you will come away from the session feeling much more confident in helping your son with his maths homework. If you have previously attended a session, you are more than welcome to come again, as we will be covering different aspects of the maths curriculum. This session will have a maximum capacity of 20 people and will be offered on a first come first served basis; however, we will also allow parents to join online via Zoom if needed.
