### **Berlin Trip**

Over the weekend, the History Department took 29 pupils over to Berlin to give them both a cultural and historical view of Germany. Visiting important sites such as the Berlin Wall, Brandenburg Gate and the parliament building the Reichstag. The boys were an absolute credit to Mosslands and behaved

impeccably on the trip and braved the thirty-four-degree heat to walk over thirty miles during the course of the trip. This was an amazing experience for our students. For some of them it was their first time leaving the country since the pandemic and for others, their first ever trip abroad. We are looking forward to planning the next international trip soon.
