ParentPay

If you have not yet activated a ParentPay account for your son, please contact the school office and a new activation letter will be emailed to you. You can use ParentPay to pay for school meals, trips, revision guides, ties and badges. You can also check what your son is eating in the canteen and keep an eye on his school meal balance. To avoid school dinner accounts going overdrawn, you can set up an auto top up which automatically tops up the account if it falls below a certain level. The top up is automatically suspended during school holidays.
