Faraday House 7 in 7 Challenge


challenges over the 7 days.

Our Book of the Week comes from Tom Palmer and is Armistice Runner. This is an emotive book that follows a serious, dedicated young girl who is keen to be the very best at her sport, and parallels it with a soldier's experience of war. Lily loves fell running. She's good, but never

quite good enough: she gets anxious and loses her focus and then that's it. Out. Plus, she's worried about her grandmother, who has Alzheimer's and is growing distant and confused. However, whilst staying with her grandparents just before her first big race of the season, Lily discovers her great-grandfather was a runner too. Not only was he a fell running champion, but he was also a message runner during WW1. Lily reads his diaries and through them discovers a hidden family history, which helps her connect with her grandmother. Can the diaries give her the inspiration she needs to win the upcoming race? This is a powerful book that is accessible for our dyslexic readers and is in the library now.
