Message from Mr Whiteley

All headteachers in and around Wallasey Village share the same feelings following the shooting on Christmas Eve which claimed the life of a young woman, Elle Edwards, and alongside the LA would like to make the following statement:

First and foremost, we offer our deepest condolences to her family, and to those who were injured in this dreadful attack in the heart of our neighbourhood.

Our school communities remain shocked and deeply saddened by the events, which appalled everyone in the area on Christmas Eve. This was a terrible act of violence, which claimed the life of an innocent young woman, a member of our local community, and made even more shocking for happening at a time when people should be celebrating being together.

Term is now underway and our students are back in class, but the impact of this terrible event continues to affect local people deeply. At this time, we are focused on supporting students and their families.

At Mosslands, we will redouble our efforts to promote understanding and condemn violence and will continue to work with all stakeholders to make our community safer with more opportunities for our future generations.

As we move forward with the plans for the new building, we are working with the local authority to ensure that the new building offers more opportunity for community sports and leisure and for adult and family learning and can be a focus for positivity in the community in the evenings, at weekends and during holiday periods. These plans are gaining momentum with the new school expected to be completed by 2024-5. As plans emerge, we will be consulting with the community, students, parents and staff, to make sure that what is delivered reflects the needs and ambition of the whole community.

Friday 13th January Years 11 – 13 - A Reminder

On Friday 13th January, students in Year 11 will have an appointment with a member of house staff to discuss their mock GCSE results and future plans. On this day, students in Year 11 should attend only for their allocated appointment in the 6th Form Centre. School uniform is not required on this day. There will also be representatives from apprenticeship provider Asset Training. Members of staff from the 6th Form will also be present. Parents are welcome to attend with their sons. A letter outlining how to book an appointment will be coming home in due course.

With the exception of pupils who have an exam or those who attend The Engineering College, 6th Form students are to work from home on Friday 13th January, while Year 11 Mock GCSE Results Day takes

place. Work will be provided in advance or will be set on Google Classroom.

Year 11 Careers

Our Year 11 are currently preparing for their mock interviews next month. It is vital that they prepare a CV using the Unifrog platform by 31st January 2023. They should be working on this at home as well as in school, it should be checked before submitting to Mrs Rycroft using the drop down menu at the bottom of the CV tool.

To access the CV tool they need to log in to Unifrog using their school email:
