



# Getting started

You can use [nimbl](#) on your Android smartphone or tablet, your iPhone, iPod Touch or iPad, or on the web with a computer. Download the free [nimbl](#) app from Google Play or the App Store to start learning on your mobile device.

## Username and passwords

Your school will give you a username and a password to log in to [nimbl](#). They will also give you your school's institution code. You will need these the first time you start the [nimbl](#) app and every time you log in to [nimbl](#) on the web.

## Using nimbl on a smartphone or tablet

We've designed our [nimbl](#) resources especially for smartphones and tablets so you can have the best learning experience anywhere you want; @school @home #onthego.

- Search for [nimbl](#) in Google Play or the App Store and download the [nimbl](#) app.
- When you start the app log in with your school's institution code and your [nimbl](#) username and password.
- You'll see all the [nimbl](#) resources your school has given you. Tap each one to download it.
- Once it's downloaded, start learning!

Android users, you will need Android 4.0 (Ice Cream Sandwich) or above. Apple users, you will need iOS 7.0 or above.

## Using nimbl online

Not everyone has a smartphone or tablet. That's why we've put [nimbl](#) on the web as well. To use [nimbl](#) on a computer:

- Go to <https://go.nimbl.uk>.
- Enter your school's institution code, and your [nimbl](#) username and password.
- You will then see the resources that your school has made available to you. Select a title and click [view now](#).

You will need Google Chrome, Safari, Firefox or Internet Explorer 9 or above to use [nimbl](#) on the web. We recommend that you set your web browser to remember usernames and passwords for this site to make future logins as easy as possible.

Make sure you don't use the web version on a phone or tablet. That's what the [nimbl](#) app is for!



## For teachers:

You have been sent a list of usernames and passwords for all your **nimbl** users. Included in this is an **institution code**, which should be given to users with their username and passwords.
